

ALBC to have a Junior Division that will include High School youth from the ages of 14 – 18 and participants must be enrolled in a local high school.

High School teams are to be made up from the local high school the team attends. Teams are not to be made up of members from different high schools.

All High School team members must belong to the Association of La Bass Clubs (ALBC). There will be a \$10 membership fee to join the ALBC.

All High School teams may set their own rules and set their own dates for their club tournaments.

All High School teams must have a sponsor. It can be a volunteer, teacher and/or a local bass club.

When the High School teams participate in an ALBC sponsored tournament, the Junior members must be accompanied by an adult and that adult must be the boat motor operator, must show proof of insurance on the boat being used. The Junior members should be the operator of the trolling motor while fishing.

All Junior members must abide by all State and National laws.

The ALBC will conduct a District Junior Division tournament in the six districts of the ALBC. Each High School Junior Division Team in each district will be eligible to participate. The winning team from each district will be invited to the ALBC Best Six Tournament to participate in the Junior Division State Team Tournament. This tournament is generally held in May of each year and held at Toledo Bend. This will be a one day event for the Junior Division. Plaques and Trophies will be awarded.

Junior members may also help sell raffle tickets and receive 1/3 refund of raffle tickets sold to be used by their team.

Junior member teams may supply articles to the ALBC magazine and also receive copies of the magazine.
